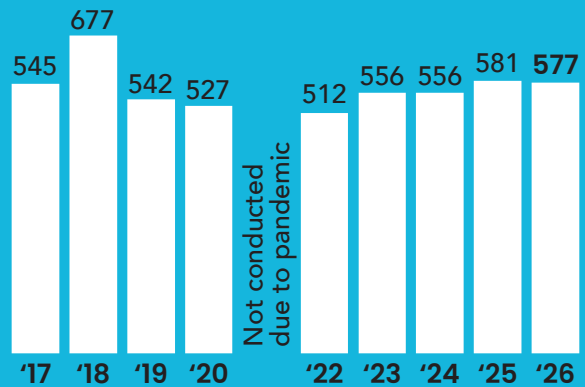


2026 PASADENA POINT IN TIME COUNT

A snapshot of our neighbors experiencing homelessness on a single night, which along with the annual count guides solutions in Pasadena.



AT A GLANCE

Homelessness remained essentially flat in 2026, but the composition shifted.

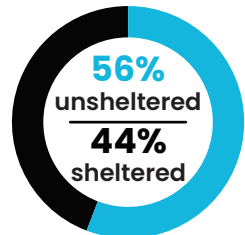

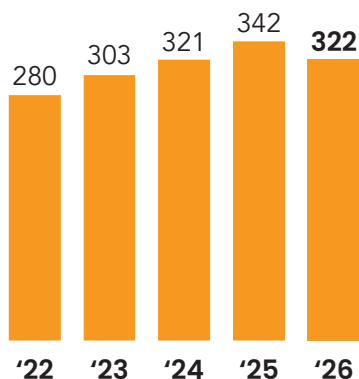

UNSHELTERED COUNT

For the first time in five years, the number of people who were unsheltered on night of the count fell.

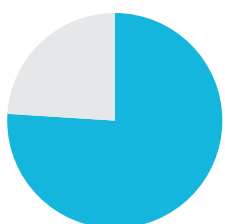

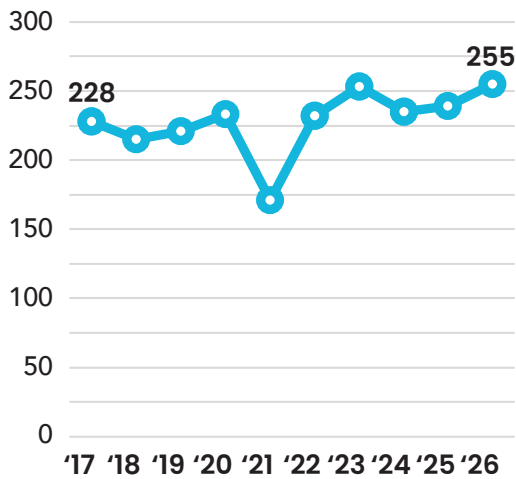
HAD CLOSE TIES TO PASADENA

57% were last housed in Pasadena (for an avg 21 years)
13% came to be closer to friends or family

29% reported they were affected by the Eaton Fire
9% reported the Eaton Fire as the reason for their housing loss

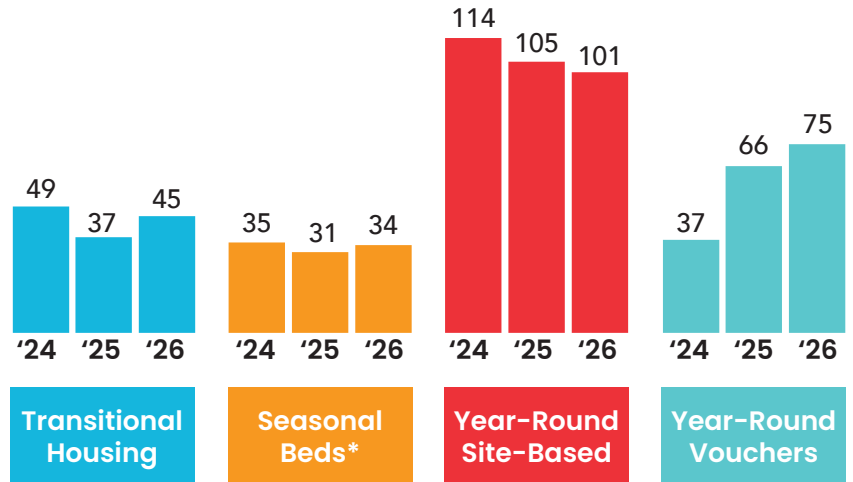
SHELTERED COUNT



Sheltered homelessness reached a 10-year high in 2026.

Close to half (47%) of people who are sheltered in Pasadena are families with children.

YEAR-ROUND SHELTER PLANNING BEGINS

Planning for the City's new year-round shelter is beginning and will include:

2 SCOPE

ALSO ON THE HORIZON

SHIFTING FUNDING LANDSCAPE

Reductions in County-administered services and anticipated funding cuts will significantly affect the homelessness response system.

NEW TRANSITIONAL HOUSING

Door of Hope's David & Katherine Lee Home is expected to open in early 2027.

SENIOR AFFORDABLE HOUSING

The 100-unit Ramona project, including 48 Permanent Supportive Housing units, is expected to break ground in early 2027.
